Australia has some of the highest documented cases of **Acute Rheumatic Fever** (ARF) and **Rheumatic Heart Disease** (RHD) in the world with children as young as 4 years of age needing major open heart surgery.

Nearly 3,500 Queenslanders are known to be affected by ARF/RHD with First Nations peoples disproportionally represented.

HeART features artists from across northern Qld correctional & detention facilities, with works portraying their personal impression of ARF and RHD and how the disease has impacted their families and communities.
